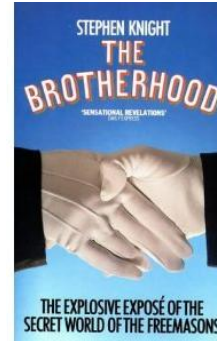


# The Brotherhood

This book focuses not so much on Freemasonry itself, but the way it is used by many for benefit. Knight shows extensive research and evidence of Freemasonry being abused in England, especially within organizations like the Police and Judiciary. Knight seems to understand the good aims of Freemasonry but points out the organization has somehow recruited many corrupt people, even criminals. He shows how many have been advanced within these groups because they are Freemasons and others neglected because they are not part of the Brotherhood. It also mentions penetration of the Brotherhood by the KGB and other sinister organizations. All in all, this is a scathing expose of a corrupted Brotherhood and the ineffectual control by the United Grand Lodge of England. I hope that this is not happening here.
